## WPG drilling campaign update on South Australian tenements

WPG Resources' (ASX: WPG) aircore drilling program on its tenements in the Northern Gawler Craton region near Coober Pedy in South Australia commenced in late April on the Nardoo South prospect within the Muckanippie tenement (EL 5154).

Within the Muckanippie tenement, 2,569 metres were drilled in a total of 59 holes has been completed on the three priority targets, Nardoo South, Duke and Regal prospects, which were identified during the 2013 WPG Phase 1 exploration program.

Samples from this drilling have been collated and dispatched for analysis with initial results should be received by the end of the current quarter.

This is the first stage of a drilling campaign on priority targets in the Company's Phase 2 exploration program on its SA tenements.

The drill target areas within the Lake Woorong (EL 4907) and Robins Rise (EL 4525) tenements will now be drilled in the coming months following heavy rains which have impeded access to the area and have delayed the second stage of the Phase 2 exploration program.


The Company is the holder of five exploration licences that cover some of the most prospective ground in the region.

These tenements, shown on the figure below, cover a combined area of 2,629 square kilometres and are considered to have excellent potential for the discovery of several types of mineral occurrences including iron oxide copper gold (IOCG), massive sulphide copper-gold-nickel, DSO haematite, banded iron formation (BIF) and gneiss hosted magnetite iron ore deposits.
